- 8. All applications must be typed. **NO HANDWRITTEN APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- 8. All applications **MUST HAVE** a College or High School Transcript attached.
- 9. **Application deadline is October 15, 2025**. Applications received by NMCGA Office after the deadline will be accepted if postmarked on or before 10/15/2025. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
