Summary/Requirements:

The NMCGA Allied Industries Committee will offer two \$500 scholarships to graduating high school seniors. The scholarship recipients will be invited to attend the NMCGA Mid-Year Meeting in Ruidoso, New Mexico, to receive their scholarship. Candidates must be accepted to an accredited college, university, or trade school. Candidates must have maintained a minimum of a 2.5 GPA , on a 4.0 scale, throughout their high school career. Additionally, candidates must have a parent and/or grandparent who is a current NMCGA member, or candidates can become a junior cattlemen member for a \$25 annual membership fee.
